January 6 through January 9, 2025**

In observance of the Funeral Service and Special Events scheduled for President Jimmy Carter beginning January 3, from 12:00 pm through January 9, 2025. There will be a temporary suspension of occupancy and construction work in the District of Columbia public space.

The closures are as follows:

Effective **Friday, January 3, 2025, 12:00 pm through Thursday, January 9, 2025**, the Temporary Suspension of Construction work within the following perimeter/designated areas:

Lane closures and work zones will not be allowed for non-emergency work in roadways, alleys, and sidewalks within the district's right of way. This includes manhole access and construction-related deliveries.

Additionally, as a reminder, please ensure that your respective construction site/project/work zone is securely closed and all materials and equipment, such as bricks, concrete, barriers, tools, etc., are secured within your locked worksite. **More specifically, anything within your permitted work zone or traffic control plan that can**

possibly be used as a projectile should be removed from the public space area and out of immediate reach of the public at the close of each business day.

If your construction site is not within this perimeter, the District Department of Transportation (DDOT)'s Public Space Inspections encourages you to be prepared for any unplanned activities arising outside of the designated area. Please govern your activities and work zones to ensure safe accommodations for pedestrians and protesters that may be close to, or inside your designated work zones.

During this time, there will be **NO** exemptions throughout this suspension of work within these designated areas. Approved activities may resume Friday, January 10, 2025, provided USSS/MPD authorization and reopened roadways.
