## Temporary Suspension of Work in the District of Columbia

Rededicate 250: National Jubilee of Prayer, Praise, and Thanksgiving

**Sunday May 17, 2026**

In observance of the upcoming National Jubilee of Prayer, Praise, and Thanksgiving and pursuant to section 103.01 Article 17 item C of the District's Standard Specifications for Highways and Structures, there will be a Temporary suspension of work in the District on Saturday May 16 through Sunday May 17, 2026, within designated boundaries listed below. **Lane closures and work zones or working exemptions will not be allowed for non-emergency work in roadways, alleys and sidewalks within the designated areas.** This includes manhole access and construction-related deliveries.

**Approved activities may resume Monday May 18, during permitted work hours.**

Per the District Department of Transportation (DDOT)'s standard practice, there will be no exceptions authorized within these designated areas identified below

Rededicate 250: National Jubilee of Prayer, Praise, and Thanksgiving.

- 15<sup>th</sup> St NW, between Constitution Ave NW and Independence Ave NW
- Constitution Ave NW, between 15<sup>th</sup> St NW and 3<sup>rd</sup> St NW
- Independence Ave NW, between 15<sup>th</sup> St SW and 3<sup>rd</sup> St SW
- 3rd Street NW, between Constitution Ave NW and Independence Ave SW
